They are asked to sit on the front row before service begins and we will then call them up to the stage, so the church can celebrate with them on their achievement. *Each graduate that wishes to participate in the recognition must fill out the attached Graduate Recognition form and turn it in to Jeremy or the Church Office by May 16.*

Graduate's Celebration: This year's Graduate Celebration will take place following the morning worship services on May 20. Graduates and their families are invited to join us at Fuddruckers for a time of fellowship and celebration. The church will be paying for the Parent's and Graduate's meal.
